

Overnight Adventures

Your group has the opportunity to see the Zoo in a whole new light. . . moonlight! It's a fun and educational overnight experience for your group to see our animals under the cloak of darkness -- one of their liveliest times!

Both adventures take place on Friday or Saturday evenings. During your overnight adventure, you will:

- Go on a personal guided nighttime safari
- Encounter animals up-close during special presentations
- Enjoy a continental breakfast
- Sleep at the Zoo
- Explore the Zoo the next day
- Shop at ZOOFARI Outpost

Once your program has been scheduled, you'll receive an information packet. Upon registration, a \$100 deposit is required and must be received within ten working days to secure the date for your overnight adventure. Full payment is due no later than two weeks before your program date. If you cancel your program within this two week period, your deposit will not be refunded.

Zoo Wild Nights

Wild Night campers arrive at 4:00 p.m. to set up campsites near the Rainforest Pavilion. Front gates will remain open until 6:30 p.m. Your nighttime safari will begin at 7:00 p.m., or 8:00 p.m. after daylight saving time.

Just bring your overnight camping supplies and we'll supply the fun! Supplies to bring include a tent, comfortable clothing, closed-toe shoes, sleeping supplies, insect repellent, flashlights, beverages, and food. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited. Campers will be responsible for providing dinner for themselves. The Rainforest Pavilion has a microwave, running water, picnic tables, and restrooms. You may use a special campfire area with campfire ring and benches (if there are no state or county fire restrictions). Don't forget to bring your own wood.

A minimum of 40 guests in your group is required for a Wild Night, with a maximum of 100. Children must be five years or older to attend.
